Dear Parents/Guardians/Family Member;

The Bradford County School District complies with federal and state law concerning the requirements of teacher certification requirements (ESSA sec. 1112(e), Florida Statute 1012.42). This letter is notification that your child has been taught for four or more consecutive weeks by a teacher who has not yet met applicable state certification or licensure requirements at the grade level and/or subject level area in which they have been assigned to teach.

Florida state law provides for the use of an out-of-field teacher when a teacher with appropriate certification cannot be employed. As of the date of this letter, your child's teacher, **See Attached List**, is eligible to teach, but has not yet obtained certification for this specific grade level or subject area. He/she is, however, currently working to obtain the required credentials within the time prescribed by the state of Florida. We are committed as a school district to work with our teachers to help them become certified in their grade level or subject area.

We want to stress to you that your child's teacher has met the requirements as a "qualified instructor" as defined in State Board of Education Rule 6A-1.0503.
