FAST FAQ's

- 1. FAST is given at the beginning (PM1), middle (PM2), and end of the year (PM3).
- 2. FAST is based on Florida's new B.E.S.T. Standards for ELA and Math
- Because the test measures a student's progress toward mastering grade level material by the end of the year, it is expected that scores for the beginning and middle of the year are lower. However, you do want to see growth from the beginning to the middle of the year.
- 4. The end of year test (PM3) is used as a final test to measure student mastery of grade level material.
- For Grades 3-10, the current
 Achievement Levels describe a
 student's success with the grade
 level standards. Level 3 indicates
 on-grade level performance. The
 Achievement Levels reported for PM
 1 and PM2 may be lower as students
 are still learning grade level
 materials.
